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## FAQ

### ARE YOU INSURED?

Yes, PyroMystiques has professional performance liability insurance of \$2,000,000.00.

### WHAT KIND OF SAFETY IS REQUIRED?

We come prepared with an entire safety kit including: fire blankets, water, water bucket, fire extinguisher, First Aid Kit & Burn Kit, safety glasses, gloves, garbage bags, safety cards, containers for fuel, and trained Fire Safety crew.

### CAN YOU PERFORM INDOORS?

Yes, we can perform indoors. For indoor performances we have a variety of fire, LED, and entertaining performances. The best way to find out what kinds of performances we can accommodate indoors is by speaking with one of our team members directly.

### WHAT IF IT RAINS ON THE DAY OF THE PERFORMANCE?

A little rain won't stop us! A light drizzle is fine, but if it's a full downpour with no signs of stopping, we are available for indoor fire/LED/entertainment performance!

### DO YOU PERFORM ACROSS ALBERTA OR FARTHER?

Yes, we are able and willing to travel! We have travelled across Alberta and beyond! Please let us know where your event is being held so we may provide you with a travel quote.

### HOW MUCH DO YOU CHARGE FOR TRAVEL?

For performances within Edmonton, AB, travel is complimentary. Our travel fees are dependent on location. Please contact us directly with your event's location for a quote.



## HOW MUCH SPACE IS REQUIRED?

The space required depends on the type of performance, amount of performers, and if the performance space is indoors or outdoors. We will also require a secure area to fuel fire props and spin off excess fuel. To determine the amount of space required, please contact us directly.

## CAN ATTENDEES TAKE PART IN YOUR PERFORMANCES?

For the safety of our performers and audience members, no attendees may participate in performances.

## DO YOU PERFORM TO MUSIC?

Yes! Our group performances are choreographed to music. Solo artists can choreograph to music. Roving/ambient performers are not choreographed to music.

## CAN YOUR COSTUMES MATCH OUR EVENT THEME?

We have specific costumes for fire performances that cannot be altered due to safety requirements, however, we will do our best to coordinate any theme considerations. Please contact us directly for specific asks.

## HOW LONG IS A SHOW VS. A ROVING PERFORMANCE?

Our fire shows are minimum 10 minutes long, with group performances extended to fit specific requests. Roving performances can be booked for 20-minute intervals. Go-go performances can be booked for hour-long intervals (10-minute sets with breaks in between).

## WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN 'AMBIENT/ROVING/MEET & GREET' AND PERFORMANCE?

Ambient/Roving is a background/freestyle performance without choreography to music. Think of it as us setting the mood. It allows attendees to get a little closer and feel connected to each performer (appropriate distance must be maintained).

A performance is choreographed to music, meant for the majority of attendees to witness and enjoy. This is a captivating and exciting display, perfect for larger events like weddings, corporate galas, festivals, or celebrations.



## CAN I HIRE MORE THAN ONE FIRE PERFORMER?

Yes! We have a group of experienced fire performers and can bring in additional talent if requested. Our prices will vary depending on the number of performers requested.

## DO YOU REQUIRE ANYTHING FROM THE VENUE FOR SET UP?

Free parking close to the performance area, fresh drinking water, and a secure place to store equipment/change in a private area. Any additional refreshments are welcome if the performance lasts for more than 2 hours.

## WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU OR SOMEONE ELSE GETS HURT?

Don't panic! We have been performing with fire for quite some time and have (thankfully) never had an injury to ourselves or our audience members. Safety comes first, which is why we bring a Fire Safety Kit and have a Fire Safety with us at all times.

## WHAT IS A FIRE SAFETY? DO YOU REQUIRE ONE IN ORDER TO PERFORM?

A Fire Safety is there predominantly for the safety of the audience members and protection of the venue, and also to provide additional support for the fire performers. We require that a designated Fire Safety must be present during any fire performance. The venue may provide their own designated Fire Safety whose responsibilities will be discussed prior to the performance.

## WHAT KIND OF SPACE REQUIREMENTS DO YOU HAVE?

Minimum Performance Space required at a performance area location varies from service to service as follows:

**Outdoors:** (Audience barrier to start of Backstage X Width of Performance Space)

- Solo Fire Performance: 3m deep X 7m length
- Small Group Performance: 10m deep X 12m length
- Large Group Performance: 12m deep X 20m length
- Ambient/Roving Performance: 2m deep X 2m length

Audience members are required to be at least 1m away from the front barrier/roving performer. Backstage Area is required for all fire shows at an additional minimum requirement of 2m deep X 3m length area. This must be deemed a safe distance by Risk Assessment from authorized personnel, and must have restricted access.



## SPACE REQUIREMENTS CONTINUED

**Indoors:** (Audience barrier to start of Backstage X Width of Performance Space X height of ceiling)

- Solo Fire Performance: 3m deep X 5m length X 4m height
- Ambient/Roving Performance: 2m deep X 2m length X 3m height

Audience members are required to be at least 1m away from the front barrier/roving performer. Backstage Area is required for all fire shows at an additional minimum requirement of 2m deep X 3m length X 3m height area. This must be deemed a safe distance by Risk Assessment from authorized personnel, and must have restricted access. Two separate areas within the Backstage must be designated 'Fuelling Station' and 'Extinguishing Area' for all indoor performances.
